Objects of the Fund

- 1. The primary object of the Fund is to help finance the publication of archaeological reports relating to Gloucestershire
- 2. At the discretion of the Gloucestershire Archaeology Executive Committee money from the Fund may be used to meet the costs of specialist reports (e.g. pottery, carbon dating etc.) which might be necessary elements of the publication of archaeological projects (either as standalone documents or in "Glevensis") and other expenses incurred by such projects.

Notes:

- 1. It is a condition of the grant that the applicant must agree to publish, and that any publication must acknowledge support by Gloucestershire Archaeology's Frocester Publications Fund.
- 2. Only one allocation of up to £1,000 can be made in any one year, the year to run from 1 October to 30 September.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

All sections below must be covered and applications be received by the Secretary at the address below by 1st September 2015

- 1) An outline of the project including:
 - i) purpose including reasons for request;
 - ii) history including dates and places of archaeological investigations where relevant;
 - iii) previous publications relating to this project if any;
 - iv) The names and addresses of two appropriate referees.
- 2) Publication plans:
 - i) Is publication agreed in principle and if so where?
 - ii) If publication is not yet agreed how do you plan to proceed?
- 3) Items requiring funding:
 - i) Specialists agreed (if appropriate);
 - ii) Estimated costs of each;
 - iii) Publication costs if any;
 - iv) Other expenses if any please itemise;
 - v) Total grant requested.
- 4) <u>Please enclose an example of a report you have written</u>, its subject, date, and if published, where and when.
